

Safe HelpRoom Sessions for Military Men

Are you a man who has experienced unwanted sexual contact or touching? You are not alone. Join us in an anonymous online forum and hear from other men who have had experiences with unwanted sexual contact.

- Who: Military men who have experienced unwanted sexual contact or touching looking for anonymous information and support.
- What: Safe HelpRoom is an anonymous, moderated group chat service that allows individuals who have experienced sexual assault in the military to connect with, and support one another. These sessions will be specifically for men to connect with other men who have had experiences with unwanted sexual contact.
- When: Every Wednesday in February

- Where: Join the conversation online at www.safehelproom.org.
- Why: These sessions provide a space where individuals who have experienced sexual assault can connect with one another to provide peer-to-peer support. Here, men are able to talk to each other and explore their experiences in an anonymous and secure environment.
